About Cal-Soap

Established in 1984, the Santa Barbara Cal-SOAP Consortium serves more than 8,000 students enrolled at Bishop Garcia Diego High School, Carpinteria Unified and Santa Barbara School Districts on an annual basis.

The mission of the Santa Barbara Cal-SOAP Consortium is to increase the accessibility of post-secondary educational opportunities for students who are the first in their families to attend college, from families of limited income, or from schools or geographic regions with documented low eligibility or college participation rates.



Programs & Services

Tutoring and financial aid advising are two of the core services provided to students and parents. On average, about 3,000 secondary school students benefit from tutoring each year. Cal-SOAP hires between 45-60 college students to serve as tutor peer advisors in math, science, English, and social science classes. Tutor peer advisors draw from their own experiences to provide information to students about the "college-going" process and financial aid. Tutoring is available in junior high and high school classrooms, after school tutorial centers, and local Boys and Girls Clubs.

Cal-SOAP collaborates with financial aid professionals from local colleges and scholarship agencies to provide financial aid workshops to every high school senior, serving approximately 1,800 students in January and February. Held during the evenings to accommodate parents' work schedules, "Cash for College" workshops help families learn about available sources of aid and how to apply for them.

Other Cal-SOAP programs and services include scholarship opportunities, college admissions advising, college campus visits, college and career planning and parent workshops. All services are free and individual appointments are available upon request.
